VI. Reading Comprehension (20 Marks)

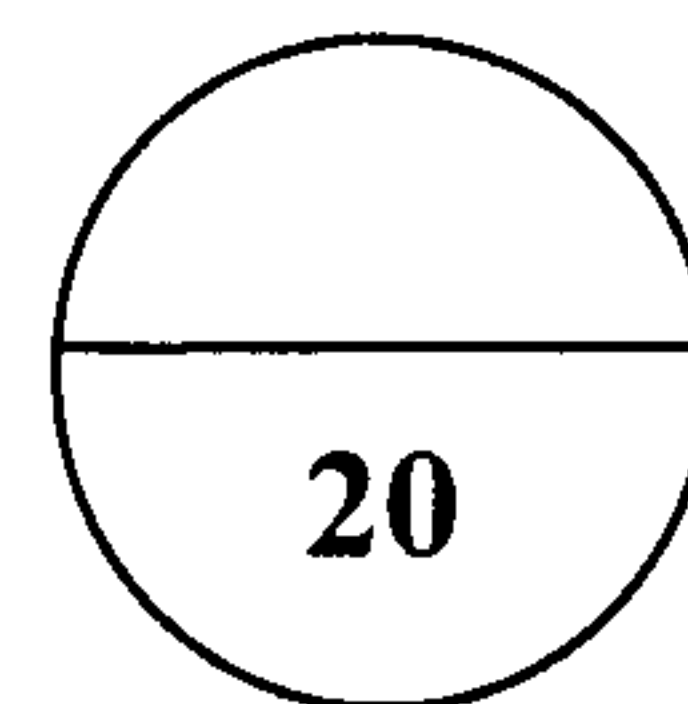
