Some animals don't drink water for a long time./ Others hide by day and come out at night./ Animals have special skin to adapt.

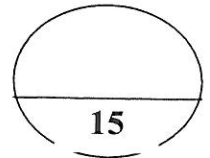

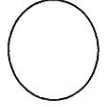
