The desire to reach the North or South Pole has always attracted sailors and explorers. Many ships have been lost in the ice during these polar expeditions.

One Swedish exploration team had the idea of flying to the North Pole in a hydrogen balloon. The leader was Andree, the experienced Arctic explorer. He took with him two other men. **They** set off on 11th July 1897 from Danes Island, in the Arctic. In the basket with the three men was food, fuel for cooking, tents, guns and sledges, in case they landed on ice.

On 14th July, got caught in freezing fog. The weight of the ice meant the balloon became too heavy to continue flying. The men could **survive** the crash into the ice. They travelled across the ice for two months, before they died. Thirty years later, their skeletons were found near White Islands by two Norwegian sailors.
